# **QUALIFICATIONS AND DEADLINES**

### **Operator Qualifications**

To participate in the Montana State Dart Tournament, an operator must:

- Be a member in good standing of the NDA
- Have one worker for the tournament to assist with set-up, brackets, as needed

### **Tournament Deadlines**

**September 22, 2024** All players participating in the State Dart Tournament must be

sanctioned by the NDA (\$10) with an expiration date of either

8/31/2023 or 8/31/2024

### **Dart Player Qualifications**

### League Requirements

All '01 games must be Opening In/Open Out format to be used for classification purposes. All Cricket games must be split bull to be used for classification purposes.

All games must be played on equipment owned by the NDA operator.

Registration is only available through and NDA operator. No onsite sign-ups will be accepted. (Except for the mixed trios team Event)

All players must be NDA sanctioned. Entrants must be at least 21 years of age.

All players must play within the same league system (same operator). No teams made up of players from multiple operators can be formed except for mixed trios team.

### Substitutes and Onsite Alternates

### Substitutes

The Three (3) highest skill ratings will be used when calculating a team skill. It is helpful to use players with similar skills as substitutes.

### **On-Site Alternates**

Only an Operator's league administrator can make player changes onsite. He or she must have stats and a copy of the entry form with them. No entries will be accepted at the tournament. Players must have equal or lesser stats to the person they are replacing to make the change. Any

### **Format**

Winner Of Coin Toss Will Have The Option To "See Or Show" On The Diddle.

When diddling, the dart that is closest to the center will determine the winning dart. You may continue throwing until one dart sticks in the target. If the first player hits the center hole in the bull's-eye, the dart will be removed to allow the other players the opportunity to tie. In the event they are the same distance from the center of the bull's-eye, the players will Continue diddling and reverse the order until a winner is determined.

Team Event will be Double Elimination format with race to 2 games (1 of 501, 1 of Cricket and the Final game if needed rediddle winners choice.

All Singles and Doubles events are Double Elimination Format.

Singles and Doubles are a Race to 2 except Level 1, which is a Race to 3.

Doubles events will use the Freeze Rule unless specified differently.

All events (except Pink Ladies) will be classified based upon criteria allowing men and women to participate.
